

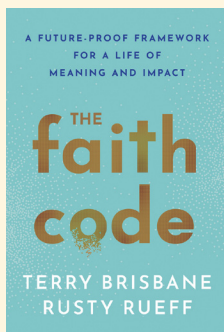
## TERRY BRISBANE
